

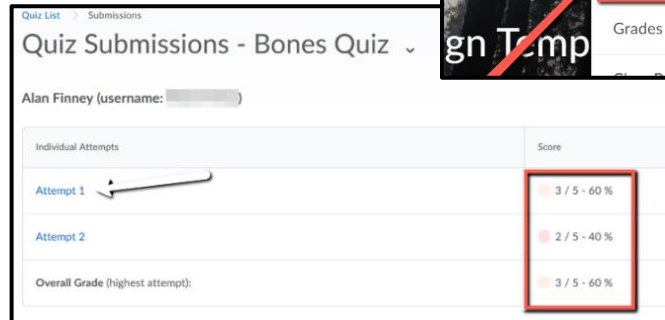
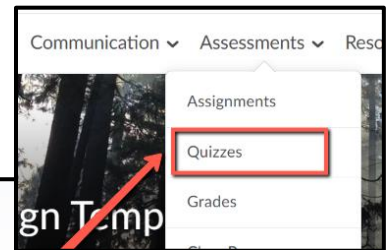

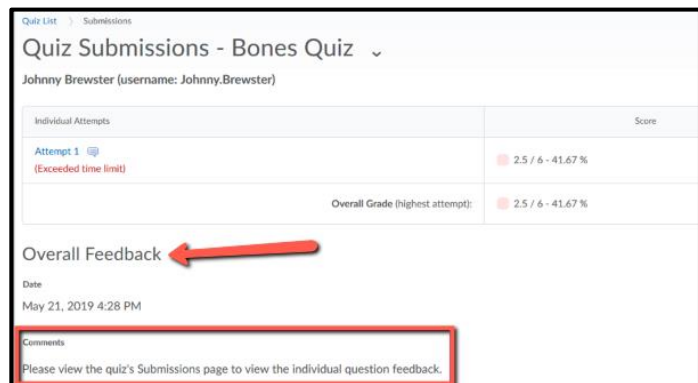
1) Viewing Quiz Results
